## Childcare Policies & Procedures

- Children must be between the ages of 2 months and 5 years.
- No refunds will be offered for cancellations.
- Parents are required to sign in and out with their children at each visit.
- Parents/Guardians must remain on the premises the entire time their children are in childcare and must respond to any requests childcare staff to attend to their child immediately.
- Blossom's services are not licensed by the Department of Early Education and Care or any other state agency
- Children will be released ONLY to the person who dropped them off.
- Please bring your child freshly diapered and bring extra diapers.
- If a child needs to use the bathroom, parents will be notified and asked to accompany the child to the bathroom and return the child to the childcare room before returning to co-working space.
- For the well being of the other children and staff, please refrain from bringing a sick child into the childcare facility. Children with any visible signs of sickness will not be permitted. These symptoms include but are not limited to: fever (100 degrees or above), diarrhea, vomiting, pink eye and rashes. Child must be symptom free for at least 24 hours before returning to Community Yoga childcare. For persistent symptoms resulting from allergies, or other non-contagious medical conditions, a child may attend with a doctor's note.
- Please label all of your child's belongings with his/her name.
- If a child is inconsolable or behaving disruptively, parents will be notified and asked to return to the childcare room to assist the staff.
- Medications will not be administered by the childcare staff.
- You are welcome to bring food for your child, Blossom will not provide food.
- Please do not bring foods that are potential choking hazards or allergens (including nuts). Staff will not be able to warm up food and refrigeration will not be provided.
- Parents/Guardians must agree that if they fail to comply with these conditions of childcare, the program will not be able to provide child care services for the child.
- Please NOTE: Rules, Guidelines, and Regulations are subject to change at anytime. Parents will be notified of any changes with new copies of the guidelines.
